ROWLAND HEIGHTS COMMUNITY CENTER AT PATHFINDER PARK PROJECT FACT SHEET

Project Description

- Construction of a new approximately 15,000 square foot, one-story, Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Silver certified community center on the lower level of Pathfinder Park at 18150 Pathfinder Road, Rowland Heights, CA 91748.
- The new facility will include an approximately 4,500 square foot multi-purpose room with a stage, and will accommodate banquet style seating for up to 300 people and performance style seating for up to 581 people; an exercise studio, an arts and crafts room, gallery, computer room and catering kitchen.
- Development will also include new tennis courts, a new basketball court, on-site parking and other related on- and off-site facilities.
- The new County-owned facility will be designed by Gonzalez-Goodale Architects and upon completion will be operated by the Los Angeles County Department of Parks and Recreation

Budget

- Total Estimated Development Cost: \$18.1 million
- The Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors approved partial funding in the amount of \$13.6 million which was transferred to the County's Community Development Commission in October 2009 for development of the project. The remaining balance will be funded prior to construction start.
