ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works is pleased to inform you of an upcoming roadway improvement project in your area.

Project Limits – Please see attached maps.

<u>Description of Work</u> – This project consists of resurfacing the existing roadway pavement.

<u>Financing</u> – The project cost will be financed with State Proposition 1B transportation bond funds.

<u>Jurisdiction</u> – The project is located in the unincorporated County area of South Whittier.

<u>Construction</u> – During construction, your street may be closed between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for one or two days. No Parking signs will be posted at least 48 hours in advance of the work on your street. Additional information will be provided prior to the start of construction, including the names and telephone numbers of Public Works personnel to contact regarding construction activities.

<u>Schedule</u> – Construction is tentatively scheduled to start in the fall of 2010 and will take approximately three months to complete.




